Saturday – 1

Dear Friends, please continue to pray for financial support for FEBC Russian Ministries. Because of you, we can preach the Gospel to millions of Russians and Ukrainians who need salvation through Jesus Christ. We thank God and you for the opportunity to inspire people to follow Jesus.

We just opened a new radio station in Pokrovsk, our 7th in Ukraine. Please pray that many non-believers who live in this city will hear the Good News through FEBC broadcasts and come to faith in God.

Monday – 3

Please pray for Oleg Cherny, FEBC Russian Ministries' administrative director. Pray for God's wisdom and guidance on his work, especially when he interacts with government officials on behalf of our ministry. Pray for God's protection and blessings for us.

Tuesday – 4

Wednesday – 5
